

#### **Ilkley Trophy 2024**

We will shortly be publishing full details of ticketing and hospitality arrangements for the Ilkley Trophy 2024, which is scheduled for 15th to 22nd June. In the meantime, here are some of the highlights and offers which will be available for members. We hope many of you will be able to come and enjoy another fantastic tournament.

- Free ground admission for all members this year we are introducing a new benefit for all members which is that admission to the grounds will be free of charge for all members for all tournament days. Tickets will still be required for reserved seating on Centre Court (from Wednesday onwards).
- Centre Court ticket member discounts Centre Court tickets will be available to members at a discount of 15% provided they are purchased in the advance purchase window (details to follow). These will need to be purchased through the LTA website or through hospitality packages (which include Centre Court tickets).
- **Hospitality packages** as in 2023, hospitality packages will be available in the Rathbones Centre Court Lounge and the Masons of Yorkshire Lounge. Inevitably prices will be increased from 2023 as a result of higher costs, due to inflation and higher ticket prices, which are set by the LTA. However the club is seeking to keep these increases to a minimum. Brochure prices are plus VAT.
- Hospitality package member discounts members purchasing packages in 2024 who purchased packages in 2023 or who registered for 'first look' will receive a 5% discount if they book before the end of February.
- **Members Monday** On Monday the 17th June, "Afternoon Tea Party" packages will be available in Rathbones Centre Court Hospitality and will be discounted by 30% to members.
- Club Championships and Summer Ball at the end of what is set to be an exciting week, on Sunday 23rd June the finals of the Club Championships are scheduled to take place, and in the evening the club will host a Summer Ball, open to members and their family and friends.
- Tournament Volunteers will receive a complimentary ticket to the Summer Ball;
- Entrants to the Club Championships will receive a 50% discount to Summer Ball tickets;

Groups of 10 or more will receive a 10% discount, providing a great opportunity to encourage your playing groups or fitness classes to come along and enjoy a fantastic end to the week.
